KALOGO MUSAMIN - FROM BED TO BUSINESS

Kalogo is 20 year old, the 6th child of nine siblings. He joined Rays of Hope Hospice Jinja in July 2016 when he suffered from severe headaches and was losing vision on left eye and the eye started swelling. In August he developed paralysis of left side, but recovered and the paralysis improved in October. Kalongo was referred by RHHJ to neurological department in Mulago National Hospital in January 2017. The findings indicated a benign cyst or tumor behind the eye. He was operated, the tumor was benign and he is now fine. His vision is restored, he has no pains, but he has still decreased use of the left arm – but he is training it and he no longer needs palliative care. His hope is to start a small business now, and we hope to find donors to help him do so.
